The second file should contain the chapter in the following structure: 1. **Title of the Chapter**, 2. **Introduction (200-400 words)**, 3. **Main Text**, 4. **Conclusion** 5. **Works Cited and Consulted**. All the research chapters would be peer-reviewed. Acceptance or Rejection will be the sole right of editors. Authors may be asked for modification after acceptance of the article is required. Plagiarism is Zero Level tolerance.
